- 4. <u>Social Isolation</u> If we have Senior Veterans that are not getting out of their home a lot and would benefit from a free tablet/ipad. Macon County Health Department has tablet or iPad for isolated seniors. There are no income restrictions on this program. The Health Department will actually go out and train the senior on how to use the tablet, if needed. Phone number is on the flyer. The only charge would be internet if they do not already have it or income based could receive it free, as well.
- 5. <u>Charity</u> So the charity can be administrated by a veteran. We need to have a board of 3, 5 or 7 members. The honor Guard will also fall under this charity to be audited as a part of the charity. We are working on by-laws. being as this Charity is here to support the office and the honor guard.
